

DRU (District Resource Unit)

Functions:

1. To help in planning and execution of training programmes for teacher trainers of formal education.
2. To serve as a central (nodal) branch for the organisation of training programmes.
3. To arrange orientation programmes for the resource persons.
4. To conduct training programmes related to women empowerment, teenage education, education for handicapped, AIDS awareness, and to impart training for the organisation of various national/international days.
5. DRU and the Assistant District Project Officer (informal education) work in collaboration to plan and conduct training programmes.
6. To impart training to teachers to educate children about the impact of increasing population.
7. To train teachers for women's empowerment.
8. To arrange training programmes for the handicapped under Integrated Education for Disabled Children.
