NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of the India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Statistical Subordinate Service Rules, 1971, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Statistical Subordinate Service (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.


2. **Amendment of the Schedule.** - The existing Schedule appended to the Rajasthan Statistical Subordinate Services Rules, 1971, shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
